
USET REQUEST FOR IHS AND CONGRESSIONAL SUPPORT OF
CALUMET OFFICE BUILDING FOR IHS AND USET USE


- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of nineteen (19) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes leadership; and
- WHEREAS, USET, Inc. is the sole shareholder in Calumet Development Corporation (Calumet), a for-profit organization chartered under the laws of Tennessee; and
- WHEREAS, Calumet is a limited partner in Calumet Motels, Limited; and
- WHEREAS, Calumet Motels Limited owns a piece of property in Nashville, Tennessee on which a Best Western Motel has been constructed, and is now in operation; and
- WHEREAS, that same property provides additional development opportunities; and
- WHEREAS, one such opportunity is the development of an office complex to provide space needed by the Indian Health Service Nashville Area Office and USET;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT USET requests all necessary approvals by IHS, and, if required, by Congress, to permit implementation of these projects, including an IHS lease of space in the office complex.
