AUTHORIZATION TO FILE JTPA APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty (20) federally recognized tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Incorporated Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes leadership; and


WHEREAS, USET, Incorporated finds that serious unemployment and economic disadvantages exist among the Indian and Native American population within the South and Eastern United States; and

WHEREAS, USET, Incorporated in past years have administered Employment and Training Programs to address these problems through the Department of Labor's JTPA program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of USET, Incorporated authorizes the President and Staff of USET, Incorporated to file application with the Department of Labor for program funds to address the needs of the unemployed and disadvantaged Indian and Native American population for the areas USET, Incorporated may be eligible to apply.

CERTIFICATION

The resolution was duly passed at the Board of Directors meeting, at which a quorum was present, in Biloxi, Mississippi on October 29, 1992.
