"THE AMERICAS BEFORE COLUMBUS: A 1992 WORLD CELEBRATION FOR  
NATIVE AMERICANS

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDING

WHEREAS the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of twenty (20) federally recognized tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes leadership; and

WHEREAS, USET, Inc. has established an Education Committee comprised of representatives from their member Tribes to provide an important delivery mechanism to promote and support education in Indian country; and


WHEREAS, there is still a great need for additional educational resources, especially with regard to increasing funding that will be utilized to enhance USET education programming.

#, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors, as a broad based Native American organization, endorses the use of funds generated as a result of the broadcast of the production of "The Americas Before Columbus: A 1992 World Celebration for Native Americans", for use in establishing an on going scholarship program for all Native American Indian students: and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these funds be used to enhance, not replace, existing USET educational funding and programs.
