**EASTERN AREA TRIBES MUST BE CONSULTED ON
SELECTION OF EASTERN AREA SOCIAL WORKER**

WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-three (23) federally recognized tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes leadership; and


WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Eastern Area Office has begun the application process for hiring the Eastern Area Office Social Worker; and


WHEREAS, the Eastern Area Office Social Worker functions in the critical role of assisting Tribes and staff in developing, funding and serving our Tribal children, families and communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors request the Bureau of Indian Affairs Eastern Area Office Director consult with and support the recommendation of the Eastern Area Tribal leaders in the selection of the Eastern Area Office Social Worker, and the final selection to occur on or before October 1, 1996.
