Resolution No. USET 97:51

HUD CHANGE OF JURISDICTION FOR LOUISIANA-TEXAS TRIBES

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-three (23) federally recognized tribes; and
- **WHEREAS,** the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the Alabama-Coushatta Tribe of Texas, Chitimacha Tribe of Louisiana, Coushatta Tribe of Louisiana, Jena Band of Choctaw Indians, and the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe of Louisiana currently are under the jurisdiction of the Oklahoma Regional Office of the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and
- **WHEREAS**, these Tribes desire to be moved under the jurisdiction of the Eastern Woodlands Regional Office located in Chicago, Illinois; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** that the United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc., support their request to move from the Oklahoma Regional Office to the Eastern Woodlands Regional Office in Chicago, Illinois.
