USET Resolution No. 2001:077

Continued Funding of the Boys and Girls Clubs of America Program

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the USET tribes depend upon the continued funding of Boys and Girls Clubs of America Programs for creating youth activities related to structured programs; and
- WHEREAS, the USET tribes need this funding in order to provide a safe, healthy community environment for their tribal youth; and
- WHEREAS, these funds are scheduled for elimination under the Bush Administration proposed 2002 Budget, and such action would negatively impact many needed tribal programs; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors supports the continued funding for these programs in the Federal Budget.
