USET Resolution No. 2003:034

REQUEST FOR \$1 BILLION DOLLARS BE APPROPRIATED FOR NAHASDA FY 2004

- WHEREAS,** United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS,** the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS,** there have been no increases in appropriations for Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA) for fiscal years 2000-2003; and
- WHEREAS,** there are unquestionable unmet needs under current NAHASDA program funding; and
- WHEREAS,** there have been increases in annual funding for National Public Housing during the same period; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors supports legislation for the appropriation of \$1Billion for NAHASDA for FY 2004.
