
USET Resolution No. 2003:044

NOMINATION OF BEVERLY WRIGHT TO THE U.S. CENSUS BUREAU'S CENSUS ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON THE AMERICAN INDIAN AND ALASKA NATIVE POPULATIONS

- WHEREAS,** United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS,** the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS,** the U.S. Census Bureau is seeking nominations for appointments to the U.S. Census Bureau's Census Advisory Committee on American Indian and Alaska Native Populations; and
- WHEREAS,** Beverly M. Wright, Chairperson of the Wampanoag Tribe of Gay Head (Aquinnah), and a member of the USET Board of Directors, has expressed her willingness to be nominated for the Advisory Committee; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors hereby nominates Beverly M. Wright to serve on the U.S. Census Bureau's Census Advisory Committee on American Indian and Alaska Native Populations.
