USET Resolution No. 2003:089

RESOLUTION REQUESTING \$1 BILLION BE APPROPRIATED FOR NAHASDA FY2004

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act (NAHASDA) provisions are extremely important to the USET member tribes; and
- WHEREAS, there is proven unmet need in the current NAHASDA programs; and
- WHEREAS, appropriations for NAHASDA has had zero growth for fiscal year 2003, while at the same time there have been increases in annual funding for National Public Housing; and,
- **WHEREAS,** NAHASDA programs deserve an equitable percentage of funding in order to diminish the enormous amount of need in Indian Country; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors supports legislation for the appropriation of \$1 Billion dollars for NAHASDA in FY 2004.
