
USET Resolution No. 2004:004

### ON-LINE LAW ENFORCEMENT REPORTING


- WHEREAS,** United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS,** the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS,** the accurate, timely gathering of information is imperative to the effective and efficient operation and administration of law enforcement programs; and
- WHEREAS,** there exists a need for tribal law enforcement departments to have an electronic format to gather statistics on criminal activity to enhance the performance of the various departments; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED** that the USET Tribal Justice Committee will work to research, develop and acquire computer technology to assist tribal law enforcement programs in gathering statistics on criminal activity to generate accurate and timely reports including detailed crime statistical reports to the Bureau of Indian Affairs-Office of Law Enforcement Statistics (BIA-OLES); and, be it further
- RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors supports the efforts of the Tribal Justice Committee to work in conjunction with the BIA-OLES District VI office to research, manage, develop and acquire computer technology to assist tribal law enforcement programs in the above-mentioned endeavor, with the technical assistance of BIA-OLES, District 6 Headquarters upon request.
