Interim Guidance for Election Polling Locations

CDC has offered considerations for controlling the spread of COVID-19 at <u>election polling locations</u>. The primary guiding principle to keep in mind is that the more an individual interacts with others, and the longer that interaction, the higher the risk of COVID-19 spread. To lower the risk, settings should offer a wide variety of voting options along with longer voting periods and any other feasible options for reducing the number of voters who congregate indoors in polling locations at the same time.

Testing Guidance in Homeless Shelters

On July 1, CDC posted interim considerations for health departments testing for SARS-CoV-2 in homeless shelters and encampments. The guidance outlines the types of SARS-CoV-2 tests that are currently available along with recommended testing approaches for both sypmtomatic and asymptomatic persons with known exposures. Community transmission levels should be considered when determiniting whether or not to conduct asymptomatic testing.
