Virtual Wetland Program Plan Writing Webinars

Four-part webinar series

What will the webinars cover?

Participants attending this webinar series will learn how to write Wetland Program Plans (WPP) to outline long term goals and actions for Tribal wetland departments. Participants will have the option of using a USET-provided template to draft a WPP that covers Monitoring and Assessment, Regulatory Activities, Voluntary Restoration and Protection, and Water Quality Standards. These topics will be covered over the course of the four-part webinar series, and every portion of the webinar should be attended by participants. The webinars will also address all EPA recommended suggestions for WPP planning, and how WPP documents can be useful for mapping out wetland program funding.

Wetland specialists and environmental staff members working on wetlands for USET member Tribal Nations.
