

NB3 Foundation offers grants for COVID-19 relief efforts in Native communities

Back in April, we launched the [NB3 Foundation COVID-19 Response Fund](#) to help provide food, supplies and other resources to Native American communities being hardest hit by the pandemic. At the time, we were focused on getting these critical supplies directly to Native communities, as quickly as possible.

Now, with the remaining funds, we will be providing support through grant awards to Native-led organizations who are working to alleviate the impacts of the ongoing pandemic in Native communities.

Grant awards of **up to \$10,000** will fund pandemic relief efforts focused on:

- Ensuring access to healthy nutrition, clean water
- Personal protective equipment and/or
- Educational supplies

Grant recipients will be selected based on their initiative, creativity, commitment and potential for impact.

Eligibility Criteria

- Organizations eligible to apply are U.S. based Native American-controlled nonprofits 501(c)(3), federally or state recognized tribal governments or programs, or Native American community-based groups with a 501(c)(3) fiscal sponsor. Schools are not eligible to apply unless they have 501(c)(3) status.

Funding Requirements

- The NB3 Foundation will begin accepting applications on **Wednesday, Nov.18** and **will continue accepting applications until all funds are distributed.**
- Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis. It is in applicants best interests to apply as soon as possible.
- Grants will be awarded as they are approved, until all funds are distributed.
- Applicants may identify the amount needed, up to \$10,000, and must provide a basic budget of how funds will be used.
- Grantees commit to sharing quotes, photos, or other media with NB3 Foundation.
