## Purpose

The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) publishes the Native American Crosscut to provide further budget transparency to Tribal Governments and entities with Tribal equities such as Tribes, Tribal organizations, Tribal members, Federal agencies, Federal and Tribal policy officials, and Congressional members and staff.
