Dear Tribal Leader,

We are writing to share that the U.S. Department of Transportation (Department) is preparing to publish a Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) regarding the Strengthening Mobility and Revolutionizing Transportation (SMART) Grants Program established by the historic Bipartisan Infrastructure Law. The funding will support Tribal, state, and local initiatives focusing on smart city and community technologies that improve transportation safety and efficiency.

USDOT released the SMART NOFO on August 8th, which can be found on the <u>SMART Grants</u> website. To inform how Tribes may apply for the SMART program funds, the Department will be hosting a Tribal Technical Assistance Webinar on **Thursday, September 7th from 3:00pm to 4:00pm EST**.
