## **USET Resolution No. 2011:020**

## TRIBAL ENERGY AUDITOR CERTIFICATION PROGRAM FEASIBILITY AND PILOT PROGRAM

| WHEREAS, | United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty- |

|          | five (25) federally recognized Tribes; and  |

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and

WHEREAS, commercial and residential buildings consume 71% of all electricity use, 49% of which is wasted; and

whereas, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires certified energy auditors and contractors to perform their weatherization retrofits and upgrades as a prerequisite to utilizing federal funding; and

whereas, certification required by States infringes on Tribal sovereignty, is not uniform, and is a barrier to Tribal participation in weatherization programs, and

whereas, the Environmental Protection Agency has established a Tribal drinking water certification program that acknowledges Tribal expertise, respects Tribal sovereignty, and could be used as a model for a Tribal energy auditor and retrofit certification program; and

WHEREAS, green jobs in energy efficiency weatherization and retrofitting is a rapidly growing profession with much potential for our Tribal workforce and provide a solution to address high unemployment rates; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Energy is working on federal standards for weatherization auditor and retrofitting job classifications, skill set needs, and certification programs; therefore, be it

**RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors urges the Administration and its Departments to work with USET Tribes to develop a Tribal Energy Auditor Certification feasibility and pilot program and to include Tribal interests in developing federal standards for weatherization auditor and retrofitting job classifications, skill set needs, and certification programs.
