**USET Resolution No. 2011:032**

**SUPPORT THE NOMINATIONS OF REGIONAL APPOINTMENTS TO THE  
INDIAN RESERVATION ROADS PROGRAM COORDINATING COMMITTEE**

- WHEREAS,** United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-six (26) federally recognized Tribes; and
- WHEREAS,** the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS,** the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) Highway Bill, which ensures the funding for Indian Reservation Roads, will expire after Fiscal Year 2011 and a Indian Reservation Roads Program Coordinating Committee (IRRPCC) has been established to help with the reauthorization of this bill; and
- WHEREAS,** each region is allowed two representatives, a primary and an alternate, to sit on the IRRPCC; and
- WHEREAS,** the Eastern Region committee seat has become vacant due to resignation; and
- WHEREAS,** the USET Transportation Committee reaffirms Damon Lambert, Eastern Band of Cherokee, as the primary representative, and support the nomination of Jody Clark, Seneca Nation of Indians, as the alternate; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors reaffirms and supports the aforementioned nominations of the primary and alternate members for the Eastern Region on the Indian Reservation Roads Coordinating Committee.
