USET Resolution No. 2011:033

SUPPORT REAUTHORIZATION OF SAFE, ACCOUNTABLE, FLEXIBLE, EFFICIENT TRANSPORTATION EQUITY ACT: A LEGACY FOR USERS

- WHEREAS,** United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-six (26) federally recognized Tribes; and
- WHEREAS,** the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS,** the USET Transportation Committee supports the National Congress of American Indians – Intertribal Transportation Association (NCAI-ITA) priorities identified in the National Tribal Leadership Paper On Transportation Policy; and
- WHEREAS,** the United States (U.S) Department of Transportation should support Indian Tribes in advocating for increased funding in all new and expanded Tribal transportation programs within the reauthorization efforts of Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU); therefore, be it
- RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors respectfully requests that the United States Congress promptly act in the Reauthorization of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users and increase funding to all Tribal transportation programs.
