USET Resolution No. 2013:029

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE UNITED NATIONS DECLARATION ON THE RIGHTS OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLES

WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-

six (26) federally recognized Tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe,

as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 13175 requires agencies to have a process to ensure meaningful and timely consultation

and collaboration with Tribal officials; and

WHEREAS, President Obama signed the Tribal Consultation Presidential Memorandum on November 5, 2009,

directing executive departments and agencies to take certain actions to implement Executive Order

13175; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of State has engaged its Office of the Special Representative for Global

Intergovernmental Affairs to work with Tribal leaders on discrete policy issues but has not established an

accountable process to ensure meaningful and timely input by Tribal officials consistent with the

requirements of Executive Order 13175; and

WHEREAS, the United States endorsed the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (the

Declaration) on December 10, 2010; therefore, be it

RESOLVED that all executive agencies that touch upon indigenous affairs should become fully aware of the meaning

of the Declaration with respect to their respective spheres of responsibility, and they should ensure that

their decisions and consultation procedures are consistent with the Declaration; and, be it further

RESOLVED that a Tribal/federal commission be established to develop a comprehensive plan for implementing the

Declaration; and, be it further

RESOLVED the U.S. Department of State work with Tribal officials to develop a consultation policy for the Department

that is consistent with Executive Order 13175.

CERTIFICATION
