


ENDORSEMENT OF THE NASHVILLE AREA OFFICE OF THE INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE FY99 CORE BUDGET FORMULATION TEAM AND REQUEST FOR INCLUSION OF \$75M FOR ISDQUE

- WHEREAS**, the United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-three (23) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS**, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes leadership; and
- WHEREAS**, the budget appropriation for the Indian Health Service (IHS) supports tribal programs, services, functions and activities; and
- WHEREAS**, the Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) calls for the IHS to consult the tribes (IHS customers) in the formulation of the budget; and
- WHEREAS**, in compliance with GPRA requirements the (NAO/IHS) has been directed to form a team (FY99 Core Budget Formulation Team) of Tribal Representatives to advocate on behalf of USET member tribes in development of the FY99 IHS Budget including the addition of \$75M for ISDQue funds; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED**, that the United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc., endorses Dr. Paula Butler, Eastern Band of Cherokees Indians; Meg Parsons, Oneida Indian Nation of New York; Don Novak, Seminole Tribe of Florida; Arlene Mack, Poarch Band of Creek Indians; Susan Hammond, Penobscot Indian Nation; Elizabeth Martin, Passamaquoddy Indian Township; and Barbara Namias, North American Indian Center of Boston, Inc. as members of the NAO/IHS FY99 Core Budget Formulation Team; and, finally be it
- RESOLVED**, that the United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc., recommends for the inclusion of \$ 75M for ISDQue funds in the FY99 IHS Budget.
