USET Resolution No. 2009:016

FY 2011 BUDGET FORMULATION EASTERN REGION TRIBAL PRIORITIES

WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-five (25) federally recognized Tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) is in the process of formulating the FY 2011 budget for submission to the U.S. Department of Interior; and

WHEREAS, the USET Tribes should be involved in the process of determining their regional priority needs and in having these priorities reflected in the budget process; and

WHEREAS, the USET Tribal Administration Committee has identified Tribal priorities for inclusion in the FY 2011 BIA Eastern Region Testimony based on Tribal feedback; therefore, be it

RESOLVED the USET Board of Directors determines that the priorities for FY 2011 Bureau of Indian Affairs Eastern Region Testimony will focus on Infrastructure, Tribal Courts, Law Enforcement, Scholarships, and Economic Development.
