Update on Federal Regulations Regarding Use of Special Enrollment Periods for Lower-Income American Indians and Alaska Natives Enrolled in Medicare Part D

The following Tribal Self-Governance Advisory Committee (TSGAC) brief seeks to update Tribes and Tribal organizations on upcoming changes in federal regulations that will place restrictions of the use of the Medicare Part D special enrollment period (SEP) for lower-income American Indian and Alaska Natives (AI/ANs) and other lower-income individuals, effective June 15, 2018. Under current Medicare Part D regulations, these beneficiaries can enroll in, change, or dis-enroll from private prescription drug plans (PDPs) at any time.
