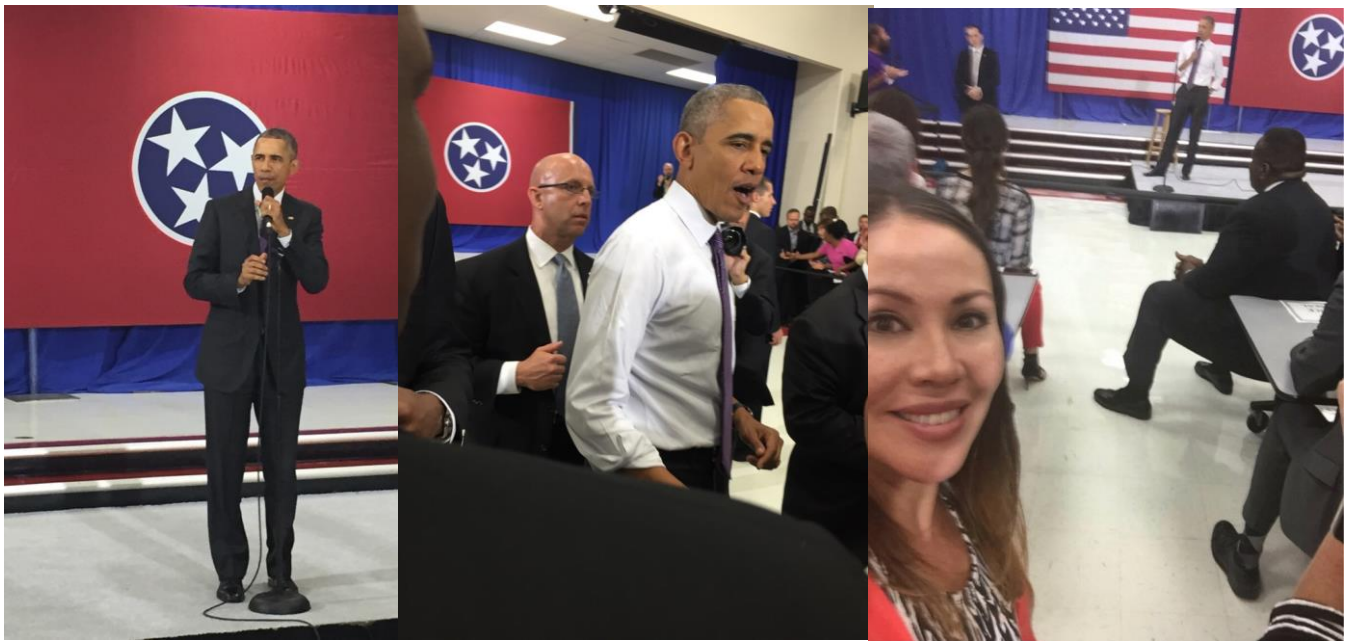

**President Barak Obama visited Nashville today to discuss the Affordable Care Act (ACA) at Taylor Stratton Elementary School in Madison. USET Tribal Health Program Support Director Dee Sabattus had a front row seat to listen.**

**The President was introduced by a local recipient of health care made possible through the ACA marketplace. The President's remarks focused on the long term benefits that the ACA will have across the country, stating, "I feel good about where health care is going." After the President's opening remarks, the remainder of the visit was designated for a question and answer session. Although USET didn't get called upon for a question, Dee did have the opportunity to thank the President, as he was leaving, for his support of Indian Country.**

**Through an opportunity from the Indian Health Service, USET along with other inter-tribal organizations worked collaboratively to develop Indian specific outreach and education materials for Tribes to educate their health care professionals and community members on the ACA. USET has also provided Tribal specific and group trainings on the ACA; training over 1000 people since 2012.**
