RESOLUTION NO. USET-1-68

- WHEREAS, a union of four Tribes of American Indians in the Southeastern part of the United States took place at a Unity Meeting in Cherokee, North Carolina, October 5, 1968, and
- WHEREAS, the Cherokees of North Carolina, the Choctaws of Mississippi, and the Seminoles and Miccosukees of Florida, desire to establish an organization to represent the united interests and to promote their common welfare and benefit, and
- WHEREAS, delegates named by the Tribal Council of the participating Tribes are meeting for the purposes set forth in a proposed Constitution and Bylaws of an organization to be named: "United Southeastern Tribes," and
- WHEREAS, said proposed Constitution and Bylaws were presented to the delegates assembled in Atlanta, Georgia on November 14 and 15, 1968, for organization purposes, and
- WHEREAS, said proposed Constitution and Bylaws were amended to add a Section 4 to Article XIII to read as follows: "Assistance to an individual tribe may be rendered upon written request to the Chairman of the United Southeastern Tribes."

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Constitution and Bylaws presented to the assembled delegates to an organization meeting of the United Southeastern Tribes, as above amended, be adopted.

DONE THIS 14th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1968, at a regular meeting of the Inter-Tribal Council, duly convened at Atlanta, Georgia, a quorum being present, by a vote of 9 for, none against, with no abstentions.
