RESOLUTION NO. USET-2-68

- WHEREAS: The United Southeastern Tribes of Indians, the Cherokee,
 Choctaw, Miccosukee and Seminole, have adopted a Constitution and Bylaws which was approved by duly elected
 representatives of the Tribes on November 14, 1968, and
- WHEREAS: The purpose of the United Southeastern Tribes of Indians is to promote the well-being of the members of their tribes, and
- WHEREAS: Commissioner Bennett, being of Indian heritage, has demonstrated a keen understanding of how to achieve progress in the Indian community and has incorporated many new concepts and new approaches to development of human resources within the Indian community, and
- WHEREAS: It is the opinion of this group that the present Commissioner of Indian Affairs has represented Indian interests well and his policies and administration have done a great deal in making lasting progress toward including Indians in the mainstream of American life.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That this organization endorses the continuation of Robert L. Bennett as Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

DONE THIS 15th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1968, at a regular meeting of the duly appointed representatives of the United Southeastern Tribes convened at Atlanta, Georgia, a quorum being present, by unanimous vote.
