Whereas, the United Southeastern Tribes are strongly concerned about developing and improving educational opportunities for Indian youth, and

Whereas, there is a pressing need for effective, innovative educational programs to promote and develop the potential which exists among the Indian people of the four (4) Southeastern Tribes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., consisting of the Eastern Band of Cehrokee Indians in North Carolina, the Choctaws of Mississippi, and the Miccosukee and Seminole Tribes of Florida, support the efforts of Memphis State University to develop educational opportunities for Indian youth of the four (4) Southeastern Tribes.
