RESOLUTION NO. USET 11-17-70

WHEREAS, the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. has a deep concern for the health needs on the Reservations of the four member Tribes, and

WHEREAS, Dr. Emory Johnson of the Indian Health Service has requested that the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. select two members to serve as delegate and alternate on the National Indian Health Board and Program Analysis Council; now therefore be it

RESOLVED that the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. designate Mr. Joe Long, United Southeastern Tribes delegate from the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, as the delegate to the Indian Health Board and Program Analysis Council, and also designate Mr. Don Osceola, Miccosukee Tribe of Florida delegate to United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., as the alternate to the Indian Health Board and Program Analysis Council.
