RESOLUTION NO. USET 11-18-70

WHEREAS, the Cherckee and Choctaw Tribes have achieved excellent results with their organized recreation and youth programs, and

WHEREAS, the Seminole and Miccosukee Tribes are in critical need of constructive and purposeful activities for their members, especially their youth, and,

WHEREAS, the Seminole and Miccosukee Tribes have been without any direction or organized programs in this important area of human activity, and

WHEREAS, the Seminole and Miccosukee Tribes recognize symptoms of grave problems in the future as a direct result of the above-stated vacuum; now therefore be it

RESOLVED that the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. and the Indian Community Action Project be directed to consult with and make recommendations to the Seminole and Miccosukee Tribes for obtaining such programs, and provide technical assistance in obtaining necessary resources to implement the same.
