- WHEREAS, the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., a nonprofit corporation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws adopted May 27, 1969, is charged with the responsibility of assisting the Indians of the Southeastern United States in the improvement of their social and economic conditions and for other nonprofit purposes; and
- WHEREAS, the physical condition and operational areas of the Choctaw

 Indian Hospital is antiquated and outdated; and
- WHEREAS, the capability of the Indian Health Service to deliver comprehensive health care to the Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indian is severly hindered.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc.

 petition the Director, Indian Health Service to resubmit

 the budget request to include the construction of a replacement
 hospital in Fiscal Year 1973.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the United Southeastern Tribes request the assistance and support of other Tribal groups and organizations.
