Resolution No. USET-10-71

Relocate USET offices

WHEREAS, the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. a non-profit corporation, by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws adopted May 27, 1969, is charged with the responsibility of assisting the Indians of the Southeastern United States in the improvement of their social and economic conditions and for other non-profit purposes; and

WHEREAS, the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. have the administrative offices located in Sarasota, Florida; and,

WHEREAS, the need for close coordination with the Executive, Indian Health Service, and ICAP staff is essential to the objectives and goals of the United Southeastern Tribes; and,

WHEREAS, the need to develop working relationships with the Regional Offices of various Governmental agencies.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. direct the above agencies to relocate their administrative offices to Atlanta, Georgia; and,

NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that these agencies be required to earmark funds for the cost of relocating the administrative offices.
