USET RESOLUTION #73-01

RE: USET YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the Ad Hoc Committee for youth representation is composed of representatives from the following Indian Reservations: Cherokee, Choctaw, Miccosukee, Seminole and Seneca, and

WHEREAS, we the youth of USET hereby seek and request a Youth Division be established within the USET staff, and USET to provide and create programs primarily for USET's Indian youth, and

WHEREAS, we the youth request that a Youth Council be established to serve as a governing and policy-making board, and

WHEREAS, we the youth request that a Youth Director be employed full-time by USET to coordinate, develop and implement new youth programs and seek out sources of funding, and

WHEREAS, we the youth request that the USET Board of Directors or USET staff delegate a member or members to assist the Youth Ad Hoc Committee in rendering technical assistance for developing of a Youth Division and Council.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors accepts this resolution and proposes to implement it entirely, acted upon this 20th day of February, 1973, at a duly-constituted meeting held in Irving, New York.
