RE: A Request that Indian Tribes be Exempt from OMB Circular A-95 to Receive Direct Funding from the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration (LEAA)

BE IT RESOLVED, United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., Board of Directors is in agreement with the National Tribal Chairmen's Association Resolution BD-5/73-No. 26 that Indian tribes be exempt from OMB Circular A-95 and receive direct funding from the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration without going through State offices.
