- WHEREAS, if there are cases where personnel are secured or removed, the Executive Director shall notify each Tribal Chairman within ten (10) days in writing of said action,
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the procedures for selection and removal of key USET personnel shall rest with the USET Executive Director, with the concurrence of the USET President, and for employees below a Department Head level shall rest solely with the Executive Director.
