- WHEREAS, The Seneca Nation of Indians is an active member of the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc.; and,
- WHEREAS, The board has been advised that the Seneca Nation of Indians has an urgent and immediate need for health services even to the extent that many of its members are entirely without health services and,
- WHEREAS, No Indian Health Services are presently supplied by the Federal Government to the Seneca Nation of Indians,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., Board of Directors fully supports the efforts of the Seneca Nation of Indians to take all action necessary to obtain necessary health services from the United States Government Indian Health Services at the earliest opportunity.
