

USET RESOLUTION
NO. 74-29

NATIONAL INSTITUTE ON DRUG ABUSE

WHEREAS, The United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., Board of Directors has become greatly concerned about the availability of funding resources for community drug abuse programs, and

WHEREAS, this Board is further informed that the NIDA has funded only three drug abuse Indian community programs out of a possibility of some 200, Indian communities needing this assistance, and


WHEREAS, this board feels that NIDA criteria for funding such proposals is not compatible with the Indian community traditions, cultural and life-styles,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that this Board directs the Executive Director to further research this situation and to inform the Congress, Executive Branch of the government and all federally recognized tribes and national Indian organizations of this critical situation and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. take a leading role in advocating a funding criteria that is compatible to the needs of Indian communities.
