USET RESOLUTION NO. 74-36

OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF RESERVATION UTILITY SYSTEMS

- WHEREAS, IHS has expended large sums of funds to construct water and sewer facilities on Indian reservations in the USET, Inc. area, and
- WHEREAS, preliminary studies show that there is not an economic base adequate to fully fund the operation and maintenance of water and waste facilities in the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. area, and
- WHEREAS, the tribes are unable to adequately provide technical and financial resources to operate and maintain water and waste facilities on their reservations.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that USET request that Indian Health Service provide technical and financial resources required to meet the needs of each utility system in excess of the reasonable fiscal base available from the tribe.
