RE: INDIAN EDUCATION PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Education Act, Title IV, part B and C, United States Office of Education has made preliminary contracts with potential grantees; and


WHEREAS, the preliminary budget evaluations are resulting in budget cuts up to fifty percent (50%) in some grant applications; and

WHEREAS, budget cuts are arbitrary and no provision is made for negotiation with grant applicants over merit basis;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., member Tribes request that the National Advisory Council of Indian Education, the Bureau of Indian Education in the United States Office of Education, the Commissioners of Education as well as the Assistant Secretary of Education, establish a proper system of analysis and for negotiation application based on the merits of each application.
