WHEREAS, USET has prepared a proposal for funding of an Economic Development Department to be submitted to HUD, EDA and various private foundation;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Executive Committee has considered and endorses the proposal for development of an Economic Development Department at United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., Nashville, Tennessee.
