Proposal for an Innovative Demonstration Program on Child Abuse and Neglect

WHEREAS, at the present time, there is no firm indication of the prevalence of child abuse and neglect among United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. (USET), member Tribes; and

WHEREAS, there is incomplete understanding of the problems of abuse and neglect among Indian Tribes as a whole;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that USET, Inc. Board of Directors support the proposal for the innovative demonstration program on Child Abuse and Neglect; and


