United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. Special Health Career Opportunity Grant

- WHEREAS, there is definite need for trained health professionals to operate a comprehensive health care delivery system at the Tribal level; and
- WHEREAS, there is a need for an improved method to motivate Indian people who have been identified as likely to return to the Indian community into the health occupations; and
- WHEREAS, direct support and guidance to potential students would facilitate enrollment and admission into the health professions; and
- WHEREAS, an orientation and introduction to the various health occupations, prior to actual training, would provide an increased understanding in choosing a health career; and
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., (USET), Community Health Department, submit a proposal for the establishment of a Special Health Careers Opportunity Program that will:
 - 1. Provide a two-week orientation to the health occupations twice yearly at a University with a strong program in the health sciences
 - 2. Provide a four-week, twice yearly, residency at a health facility that provides care to the Indian people
 - 3. Provide a mechanism for information dissemination of health career opportunities through the establishment of Health Career Clubs, Newsletters and conferences
 - 4. Provide academic guidance and support to meet criteria for health training programs
 - 5. Provide limited financial support and to assist in the seeking of other resources to finance training.
