ENDORSEMENT OF PROPOSAL FROM USET, INC., PLANNING DEPARTMENT

- WHEREAS, the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., (USET) has a Planning Department which has proven to be an extremely useful resource to the USET member Tribes;
- WHEREAS, there is a definite need to research and gather data that will assist Tribal governments to develop plans for their increasing aged population;
- WHEREAS, there are extremely limited services available to aged Indians on the reservations;
- WHEREAS, reluctance on the part of local and state agencies to provide services to Indian people has clearly been shown in the past, resulting in Indian people usually having last priority in the allocation of resources and services;
- WHEREAS, the Planning Department of USET has prepared a proposal "An Unsolicited proposal for Research into the Social Aspects of Aging" to be submitted to the Division of Advanced Productivity and Technology, Public Policy and Human Resources Programs, National Science Foundation, Washington, D.C.;
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Committee of USET endorses the proposal "An Unsolicited Proposal for proposal for Research into the Social Aspects of Aging," to be submitted to the Division of Advanced Productivity and Technology, Public Policy and Human Resources Programs, National Science Foundation, Washington, D.C.;
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Committee directs USET to submit the proposal to the National Science Foundation together with a copy of this endorsement.
