WHEREAS: The Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians has, for the past three

years, received grants under Title IV of the Indian Education Act for a Cherokee Star program, and on June 1, 1977, submitted

application for a fourth year; and

WHEREAS: The Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians has not received normal

notification of denial of its grant application from the Office of Indian Education, of HEW, but has been told informally that

the program is being terminated; and

WHEREAS: It appears that project officers in Washington were instructed

not to notify applicants of denials unless the applicants made

inquiries; and

WHEREAS: The Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians believe that considerations

other than grant standards were used in determining the Cherokee

Star program would not be renewed in Cherokee.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT USET does hereby formally protest the unfair

consideration and treatment of the Office of Indian Education of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indian's application for Title IV

Be it further resolved that USET formally request the Secretary of the appropriate division of HEW to make a full investigation into the

procedural standards and means used to determine the awarding of the Cherokee Star Grant and the possible abuse of standards and

procedures by the Office of Indian Education.
