- Whereas the control of the USET Inc. programs on a day to day basis is of utmost concern to the Board of Directors to eliminate any programatic deficiencies such as have occurred in the past, and
- Whereas there is a need for a position within the USET Inc. organizational structure with not only the responsibility but also the authority to carry on the day to day operation at USET Inc. in the absence of the Executive Director,
- Now therefore be it resolved that the Board of Directors of USET Inc. establishes the position of Assistant Director responsible to the Executive Director for the day to day operation of programs and policies of USET Inc., and
- Tow therefore be it further resolved that Mr. Rex J. Evans is appointed to that position.
