WHEREAS, education is a priority issue at each tribe and the National Advisory Council on Indian Education (NACIE) has in the past demonstrated it's effectiveness in advocacy for Indian education, and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Minerva C. White has served on the NACIE in the past and has shown her effectiveness in representing the concerns of the eastern tribes;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the United South and Eastern Tribes support the appointment of Mrs. White to NCAIE for the upcoming term.
