- WHEREAS, the need for a more adequate funding is apparent based on the demonstrated need as indicated in the letter from St. Regis Mohawk to USDA;
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the United South and Eastern Tribes wholeheartedly supports the efforts of the St. Regis Mohawk tribe to secure proper funding for the necessary programs for their people.
