Resolution No. 79-21

WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes is an inter-tribal council representing ten federally recognized American Indian Tribes in the Eastern United States, and

WHEREAS, Indian Health Service has up to this point not allowed the extern program of P.L. 94-437 to be utilized by those tribes, who having P.L. 93-638 tribal contracts and no federal employees; and

WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc. Board of Directors feel that this does not represent the interest of the extern program 94-437; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of USET, Inc. recommends that the internal policies be modified to facilitate the participation of tribes with contracts in the extern program.
