- WHEREAS, NIAAA has requested that the Coushatta Tribe submit another proposal for funding; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of USET, Inc. strongly supports the Coushatta Tribe; now
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors strongly support and recommend that NIAAA make every effort to fund the Coushatta Tribe of Louisiana;
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Rex J. Evans, Executive Director of USET, forward this resolution to the necessary agencies.
