WHEREAS, the Coushatta Tribe of Louisiana is in urgent need of an alcohol and mental health program; and

WHEREAS, the Coushatta Tribe of Louisiana did apply to NIAAA for a program and was not funded; and

WHEREAS, NIAAA has requested that the Coushatta Tribe submit another proposal for funding; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of USET, Inc. strongly supports the Coushatta Tribe; now


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Rex J. Evans, Executive Director of USET, forward this resolution to the necessary agencies.
