Resolution No. 83-128

Whereas, The United South and Eastern Tribes is an Inter-Tribal Council which represents twelve federally recognized American Indian Tribes in the Eastern United States; and

Whereas, the Calumet Center is important to the present and future operations and development of the services of the United South and Eastern Tribes; and

Whereas, the United South and Eastern Tribes in a bequest has been authorized to use said bequest for the benefit of the Indian people served by USET, Inc.; and


Whereas, the Calumet Center will be of great benefit, both emotionally and financially to the membership of USET; and now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the AOC is authorizing the transfer of said bequest to the Calumet Development Corporation for use as collateral for the purchase of 2.5 acres of land for the Center site; and now

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that these funds shall be returned to the USET Scholarship Fund when they are paid back through the bond issuance for the development of the Calumet Center.
