WHEREAS, the Nashville Program Office, Indian Health Service was formed in 1972 to provide services to the Indian people east of the Mississippi, and

WHEREAS, the Eastern Tribes, because of thier unique relationship with the Indian Health Service through the Nashville Program Office, have seen a dramatic rise in the level of health of their people, and

WHEREAS, this rise in the level of health through the close working relationship between the Nashville Program Office and the tribes organization, United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc. and

WHEREAS, the Eastern Tribes are constructing an office building for thier organization, USET, and are providing space for the Nashville Program Office, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eastern Tribes want to continue the close relationship with the Nashville Program Office in order to continue the improvement of the health status of thier people, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Eastern Tribes request of Dr. Rhodes, Director of Indian Health Service, the approval to have the Nashville Program Office move to the "Calumet Center" with USET upon it's completion.
